

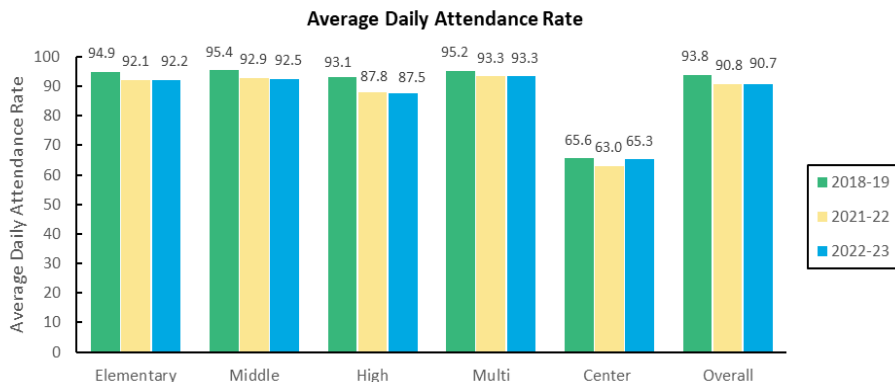

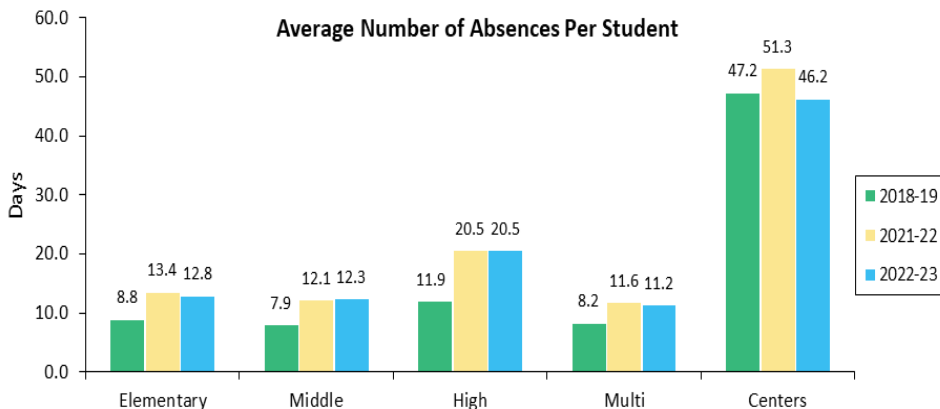

- The average daily attendance rate decreased by 3.1 percentage points between 2018-19 and 2022-23.
- Attendance was lower for high schools (88%) compared to elementary, middle, and multi-level schools (92% and 93%). Attendance at centers was the lowest (65%).
- Black, Hispanic, and White students had the similar daily attendance rate (90% to 91%). However, Black students had a higher proportion of unexcused absences (71%) than Hispanic (60%) or White students (47%).
- Average absence per student ranged from 11 at multi-level schools to 46 at centers during the 2022-23 school year.
- Students with at least 75% excused absent achieved proficiency scores on FAST and EOC assessments in reading (7 percent points) and math (9.5 percent points) than unexcused absent students.
- Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students with chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (22%), followed by middle (25%), elementary (27%), high (44%) and centers (76%).

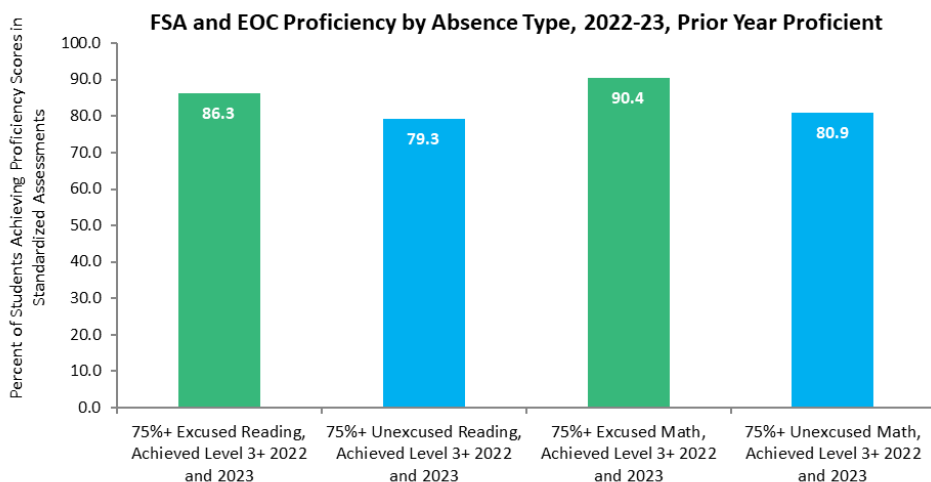
Attendance Rate by School Level

SUBJECT: **STUDENT ATTENDANCE IN BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS (BCPS), 2018-2019, 2021-2022, AND 2022-2023**

Broward County Public School's overall average daily attendance rate (ADA) decreased by 3 percentage points between the 2018-2019 (93.8%) and 2021-2022 (90.8%) school years and remained constant during the 2022-2023 school year. The ADA rate was similar for elementary, middle, and multi-level schools (ranging from 92.2% to 93.2%) in 2022-2023. High schools were lower (87.5%), and centers showed the lowest ADA rate (65.3%).

During the most recent school year, ADA rates were similar for Black, Hispanic, and White students (90.2%, 90.7%, and 91.2%, respectively). However, absences varied by type for each group. Of all absences recorded, Black students had the largest proportion of unexcused (compared to excused) absences (71.2%) followed by Hispanic (59.5%) and White students (46.9%).

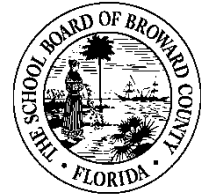
Differences in 2022-2023 achievement test performance were explored by the type of absence, excused vs. unexcused. Students with a majority of excused absences tended to perform higher than students with a majority of unexcused absences, even when controlling for prior performance. For example, in reading among those who achieved proficiency in the prior year, 86.3% of students in the 75% or greater excused absence group achieved proficiency scores in 2022-2023 compared to 79.3% of students in the 75% or greater unexcused absence group.

Broward data for the 2022-2023 school year were examined using the attendance categories that align with the School Improvement Plans. The categories are Satisfactory (0 – 4.9% absences), At-Risk (5 – 9.9% absences), Chronic Absence (10 – 19.9% absences), and Severe Chronic Absenteeism (20% or more absences). For students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism, Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion (22.3%), followed by middle (24.7%), elementary (27.3%), high (43.8%), and centers (76.1%).

STUDENT ATTENDANCE IN BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS 2018-2019, 2021-2022, AND 2022-2023

This brief summarizes attendance trends in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) for the three school years 2018-2019, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023.

METHOD

Data from all three school years, excluding summers, were gathered from the District's data warehouse for all district schools (district-managed and charter). For each school year, the total population reflects the number of students in grades kindergarten through 12 who attended a BCPS school for at least five days during the year. Student absences are credited to the school the student attended the most during that school year. Absences are classified as excused (parent/guardian notified the school), unexcused (no parent/guardian notified the school), or suspension (external suspension). The 2018-2019 school year has been included to measure changes in attendance from pre-pandemic years. Results are presented in figures and tables, and additional materials are included in appendices.

OVERALL ATTENDANCE

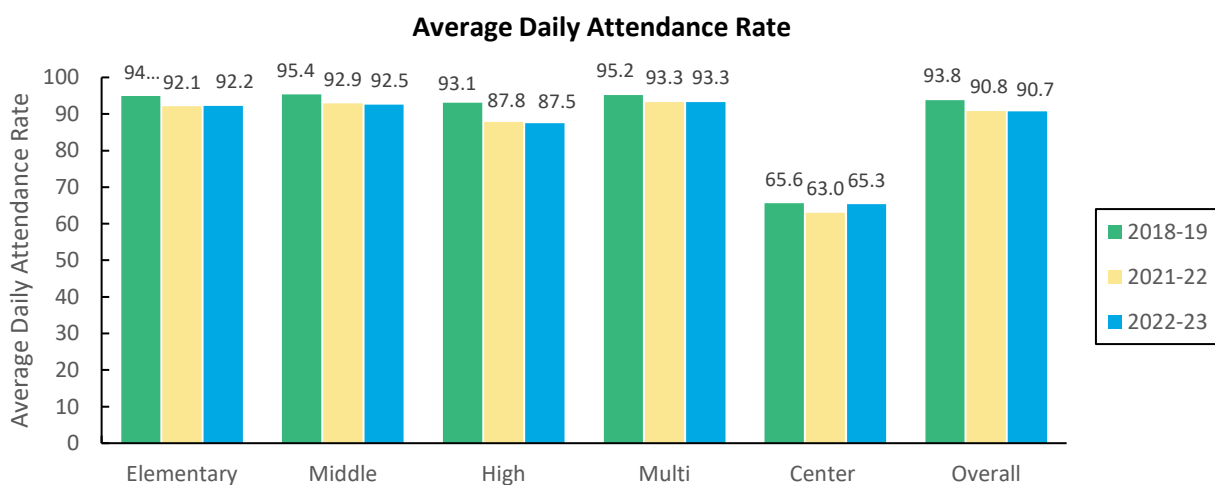


Figure 1. Average daily attendance rate, by school level, 2018-2019, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023.

The overall District average daily attendance (ADA) rate decreased from 93.8% in 2018-2019 to 90.8% in 2021-2022 and remained consistent through 2022-2023 at 90.7%. Figure 1 illustrates the ADA rate by school level for the three years (also see Appendix A).

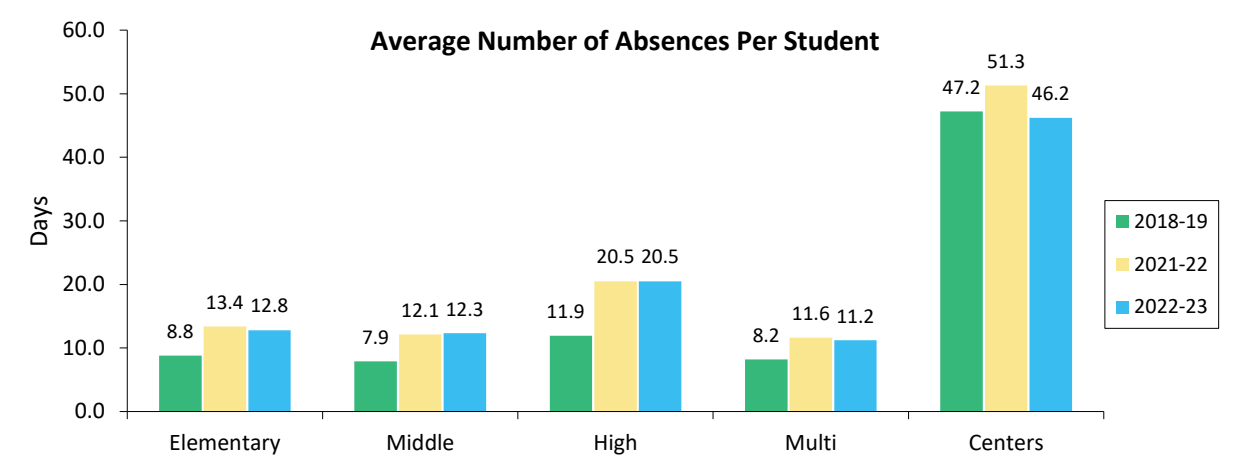


Figure 2. Average number of absences per student, by school level, 2018-2019, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023.

Figure 2 shows the average number of days absent per student by school level for the three years. Historically, high school students averaged more days absent than middle, elementary, and multi-level students. Over the three years, the average number of recorded absences increased at all school levels. Students at centers averaged more than two times as many days absent than students at the high school level (also see Appendix B).

Table 1 displays the average daily attendance rate by race/ethnicity for the three years. For the District, the ADA decreased by a 3 percent point difference between 2018-2019 and 2021-2022 and remained consistent during the 2022-2023 school year. Black, Hispanic, and White students all had relatively the same average daily attendance rate (93.7, 93.8, and 93.9, respectively) in the 2018-2019 school year and their average daily attendance rate decreased in the 2021-2022 school year (90.1, 90.9, and 91.4, respectively). The attendance rates for all three groups stayed consistent through the 2022-23 school year. In all three years, Asian students had the greatest average daily attendance rate (also see Appendix C).

Table 2 displays the number and percent of students with perfect attendance and students with fifteen or more total absences, by school level. Centers had the highest percentage of students with perfect attendance (10.4%), followed by multi-level (9.5%) and middle schools (3.6%). Elementary schools and high schools had the lowest percent of students with perfect attendance (2.9%, and 2.6%, respectively). Centers had the highest percentage of students with fifteen or more absences (74.6%). High schools had the next highest (49.4%), followed by elementary (32.6%), middle schools (29.5%), and multi-level (27.3%). Over the three years, the percentage of no absences decreased at all school levels with the exception of centers, which saw an increase in perfect attendance from 4.8% to 10.4%. The percentage of students with fifteen or more absences increased at all school levels from 2018-2019 to 2022-2023 except for centers.

ABSENCES BY TYPE: EXCUSED, UNEXCUSED, AND SUSPENSION

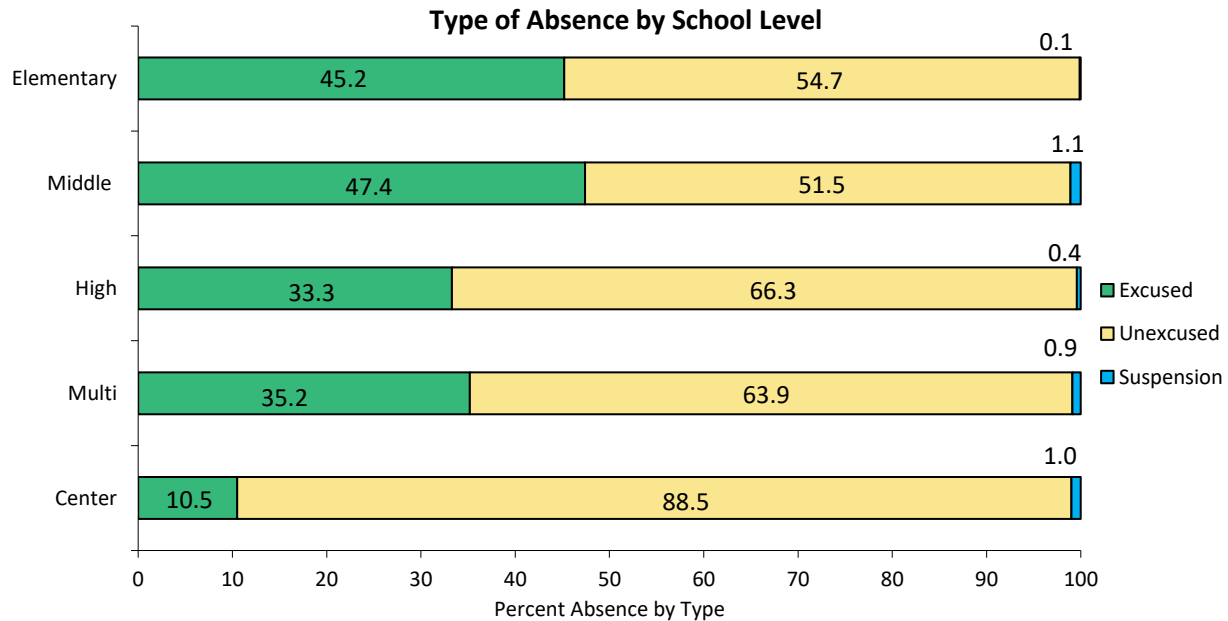


Figure 3. Rate of absence by type and by school level, 2022-2023.

Figure 3 shows the percent of absences disaggregated by type: excused, unexcused, and suspension, by school level for 2022-2023. Centers had the highest percentage of unexcused absences (88.5%), followed by high schools (66.3%). The school level with the lowest percentage of unexcused absences was middle school (51.5%; also see Appendix D).

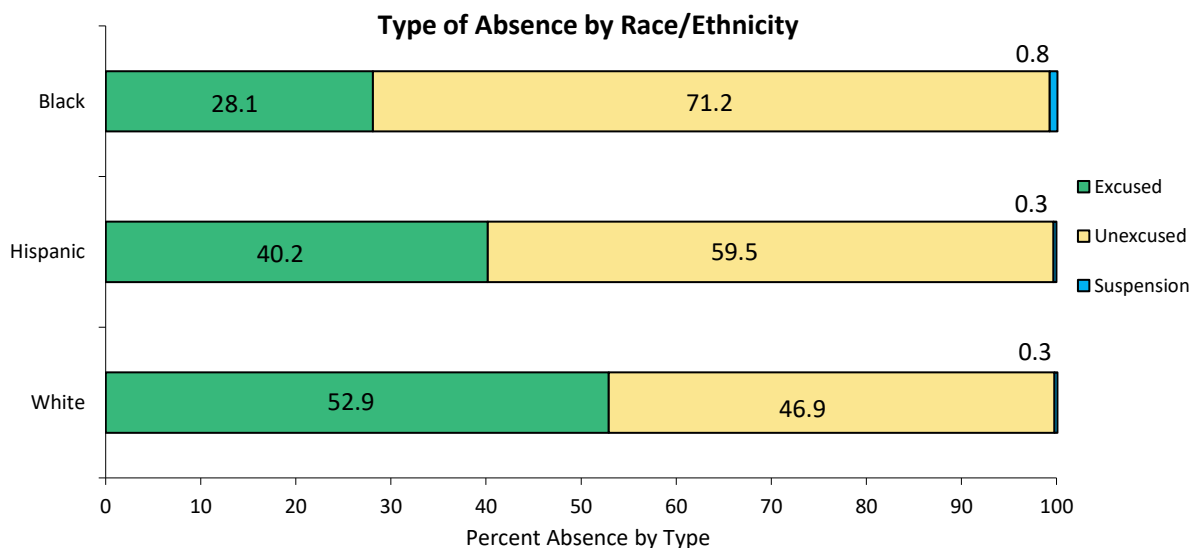


Figure 4. Rate of absence by type and by largest racial/ethnic groups, 2022-2023.

Figure 4 shows the percent of excused, unexcused, and suspension data based on the total number of absences, by the largest student racial/ethnic groups. The data show that although Black, Hispanic, and White students' average daily attendance rate did not differ by much (90.1%, 90.9%, and 91.4%, respectively), Black students registered a higher unexcused absence percentage (71.2%) than Hispanic (59.5%) or White students (46.9%; also see Appendix E).

ABSENCE TYPE AND ACHIEVEMENT PERFORMANCE

Differences in 2022-23 achievement test performance were explored by the type of absence, excused vs. unexcused. For this analysis, we looked at the percentage of absences that were excused vs. unexcused, focusing on only those students with at least one absence in grades 03 through 10. Reading Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST), or FAST English Language Arts (ELA) (N = 72,159) and math (FAST mathematics and End of Course (EOC) exams for Algebra I and Geometry) (N = 64,004) were compared.

For this analysis, we used FAST and EOC proficiency from the 2022-2023 school year by percent of absences that were excused while controlling for prior year reading and math proficiency. That is, we held constant the following factors: total number of absences in 2022-2023, and prior year achievement level on the Florida Standard Assessments (FSA) or EOCs' of interest.

For visualization purposes, we looked at two groups, those who had 75% or greater of their absences excused and those who had 75% or greater of their absences unexcused. These two groups were closely matched on the number of total absences they had in the 2022-2023 year overall. Among those students with scores for ELA and Math in 2022 and 2023, students with 75% or greater excused absences averaged 11.0 absences (n = 28,127), and students with 75% or greater unexcused absences averaged 12.3 absences (n = 34,875).

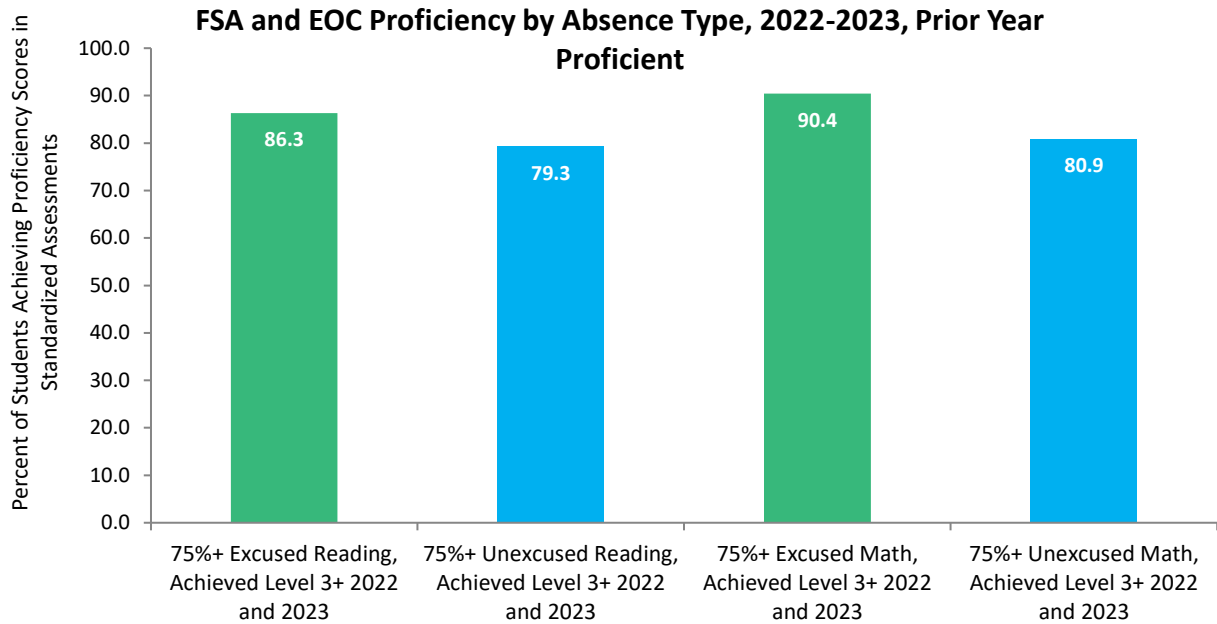


Figure 5. Percent of students proficient on standardized ELA and math assessments (FSA and EOC exams), by absence type for the 2022-2023 school year who were proficient in the prior year.

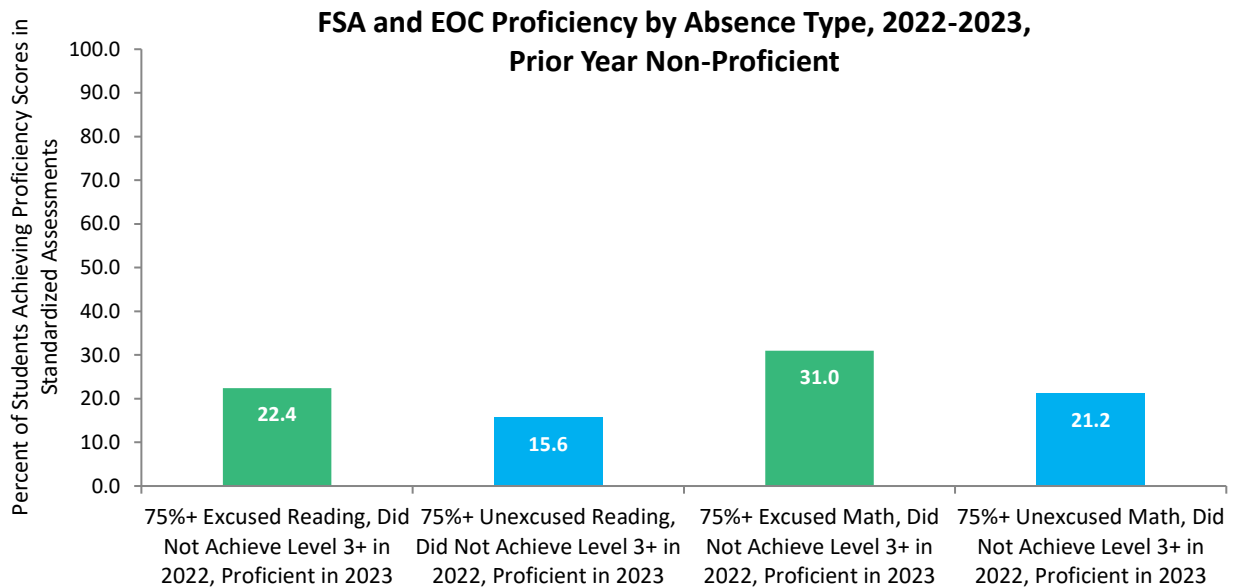


Figure 6. Percent of students proficient on standardized ELA and math assessments (FSA and EOC exams), by absence type for the 2022-2023 school year who were non-proficient in the prior year.

As an example, for reading, among those who achieved proficiency in the prior year, 86.3% of students in the 75% or greater-excused group achieved proficiency scores in 2022-23 compared to 79.3% of students in the 75% or greater -unexcused group. For reading, among those who did not achieve proficiency in the prior year, 22.4% of students in the 75% or greater -excused group achieved proficiency in 2022-23, compared to just 15.6% of students in the 75% or greater -unexcused group. A similar pattern emerged for mathematics (see Figures 5 and 6 and Appendix F).

ATTENDANCE CATEGORIES IN 2022-2023

Passed by Congress in 2015, the federal education law, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), replaces No Child Left Behind (U.S. Department of Education, 2017). States must include five indicators of school quality, four on academic achievement, and a fifth, non-academic measure. Many states chose chronic absenteeism as the fifth indicator (Jordan & Miller, 2017). Florida's ESSA plan requires school districts to implement an early warning system that identifies students in K-8 who may need additional support to succeed in school. As part of the early warning system, attendance must be included (Florida Department of Education, 2018).

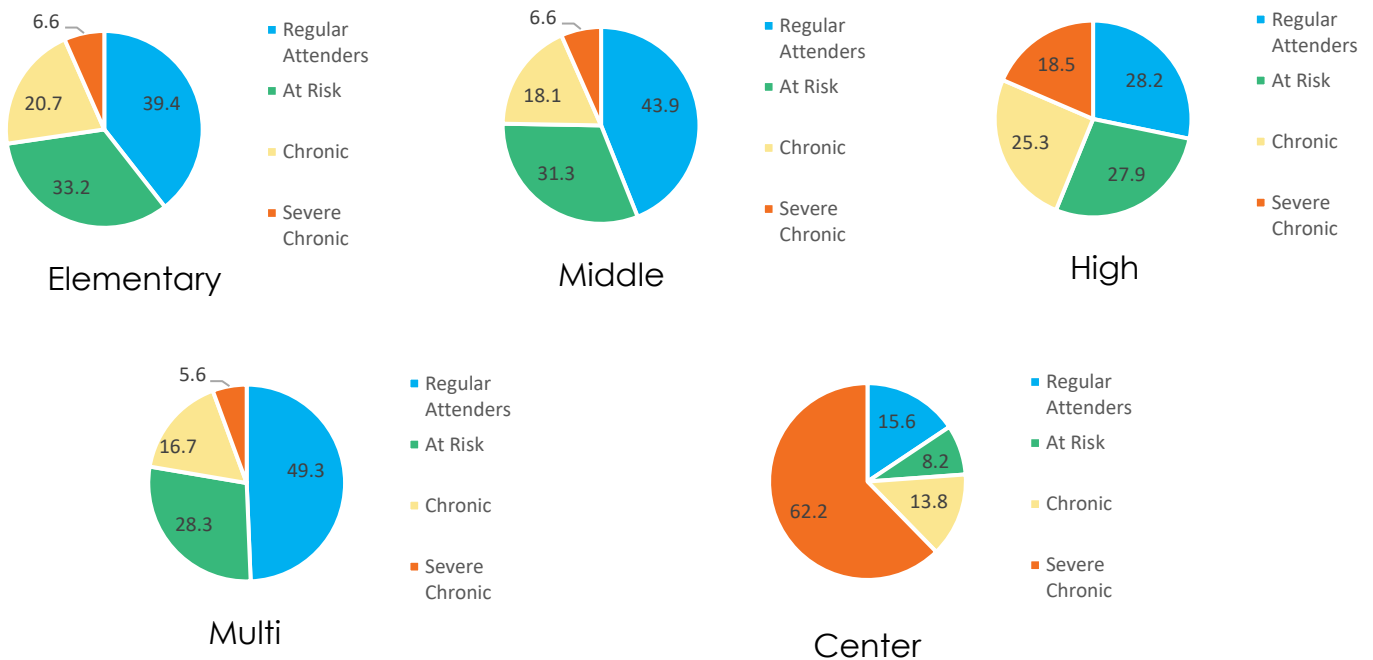


Figure 6. Percent of students absent by school level and attendance category for the 2022-2023 school year.

Broward data for the 2022-2023 school year were examined using the attendance categories that align with the School Improvement Plans (SIP). The categories are Regular Attenders (0 – 4.9% absences); At-Risk (5 – 9.9% absences); Chronic Absenteeism (10 – 19.9% absences); and Severe Chronic Absenteeism (20% or more absences). Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (22.3%), followed by middle (24.7%), elementary (27.3%), high (43.8%), and centers (76.1%); (see Figure 6 and Appendix G).

SCHOOL LEVEL ATTENDANCE INFORMATION IN 2022-2023

Three years of detailed attendance information at the school level, including absence by type, students with 10 or more unexcused absences, students with 15 or more total absences, the average daily attendance rate, and the average number of absences per student, are available in Appendix H.

SUMMARY

Overall Trends in Attendance

- The District's average daily attendance rate decreased by 3.1 percentage points from 2018-2019 (93.8%) to 2022-2023 (90.7%) (see Figure 1 and Appendix A).
- Attendance was lower for high schools (87.5%) compared to elementary (92.2%), middle (92.5%), and multi-level schools (93.3%). Attendance at centers was the lowest (65.3%) (see Figure 1 and Appendix A).
- Students enrolled at centers missed an average of 46 days during the 2022-2023 school year. On average, high school students missed 21 days, elementary school students missed 13 days, and middle school students and multi-level school students missed 12 and 11 days during the same period (see Figure 2 and Appendix B).
- Black, Hispanic, and White students all had slightly different average daily attendance rates (90.2%, 90.7%, and 91.2%, respectively) in the 2022-2023 school year, while in all three years, Asian students had the greatest average daily attendance rate (see Table 1 and Appendix C).

Attendance Type in 2022-2023

- *Perfect attendance:* Centers had the highest percentage of students with perfect attendance (10.4%), followed by multi-level schools (9.5%), middle schools (3.6%), and elementary schools (2.9%). High schools had the lowest percentage of students with perfect attendance (2.5%; see Table 2).
- *Fifteen or more absences:* Centers had the highest percentage of students with 15 or more absences (74.6%). High schools had the next highest (49.4%), followed by elementary (32.6%), middle (29.5%), and multi-level schools (27.3%; see Table 2).
- *Unexcused absences by school level:* Centers had the highest percent of unexcused absences (88.5%), followed by high schools (66.3%). The lowest percent of unexcused absences was in middle schools (51.5%; see Figure 3 and Appendix D).
- *Unexcused absences by race/ethnicity:* Black students had a higher percentage of unexcused absences (71.2%), compared to Hispanic students (59.5%), and White students (46.9%; see Figure 4 and Appendix E).

Attendance Type and Achievement in 2022-2023

- *Students who had the majority of their absences excused performed slightly better on both reading and mathematics assessments than did students who had the majority of their absences unexcused (see Figures 5 and 6 and Appendix F).*

Attendance Categories in 2022-2023

- Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (22.3%), followed by middle (24.7%), elementary (27.3%), high (43.8%), and centers (76.1%; see Figure 6 and Appendix G).

Discussion

The Student Services Department, responsible for monitoring attendance and initiating policy change, has taken the following actions to address attendance in the past year:

Mandatory Training and Attendance Recordkeeping

The BCPS Attendance Office conducted mandatory training sessions for teachers, principals, and attendance clerks in preparation for the 2022-2023 school year. These sessions were coordinated in collaboration with the Professional Development Standards & Support Department and were delivered via the Canvas learning platform. The training encompassed a comprehensive review of Florida laws and District policies, guidelines for maintaining accurate attendance records, and a clarification of the roles of each group involved in the attendance process.

Furthermore, the training emphasized best practices aimed at enhancing regular attendance. Throughout the school year, consistent communication was disseminated to administrators, staff, and various stakeholders, emphasizing the critical importance of precise attendance recordkeeping. This communication included updates to attendance codes, ensuring that an appropriate attendance code was logged for each student on every school day.

The Coordinator for District Attendance remained readily available as a valuable resource for school-based staff, school leaders, and parents, offering guidance on aligning practices with policies and addressing individual student-related attendance queries.

Attendance Awareness Activities 2022-2023

In the 2022-2023 school year, the Miami Marlins, the Miami Dolphins, and the Miami Heat continued their partnership with the BCPS Attendance Office. Students with outstanding attendance records continued to receive recognition and were offered incentives to further encourage and improve student attendance. Parents received notifications through the ParentLink system, including voice messages, email, and text messages. As part of the Good Student Program, the Miami Marlins organization generously provided approximately 100,000 eligible students in BCPS with complimentary game tickets, including discounts for additional tickets.

School Improvement Plan (SIP) Attendance Plan

For the 2022-2023 school year, the SIP Attendance Plan was instrumental in helping schools establish specific attendance goals, individually tailored for each school, and drafted with the assistance of the District Attendance Office. School Leadership teams were tasked with the regular monitoring and assessment of attendance metrics, including Regular Attenders, At-Risk, Chronic, and Severely Chronically absent students. Data gathered by this office facilitated the identification of targeted communication and support for students and parents with specific needs. Each school's administrative team, often guided by one or more support teams, such as the Collaborative Problem-Solving Team, determined the next steps for each student, ensuring that all students received an attendance code for each school day.

In April of 2022, the District Attendance Office collaborated with the School Social Work program to participate in a webinar training series offered by Attendance Works. Over the course of two months, a group of 200 participants, facilitated by the Attendance Coordinator and Social Work Supervisors, worked together to update the attendance goals SIP for SY22-23.

All schools used a comprehensive digital template for schools to complete the attendance section of the SIP, accompanied by a tiered intervention plan based on a Functional "Whole School" Support Model. At each tier, strategies and interventions were outlined, covering Data Monitoring, Student and Family Engagement, Recognition of Good and Improved Attendance, Personalized Outreach, and Barrier Removal.

District Attendance Committee

As a testament to the dedication of the District Attendance Committee, the committee remained an active and engaged group, comprising both internal and external stakeholders. Their responsibilities included analyzing trends in student attendance data, evaluating the outcomes of School Improvement Plans, and planning the annual end-of-year perfect attendance celebration. The committee supported the maintenance of the SIP Data Dashboard to support all schools with new goals. This dashboard is accessible in the Mandatory Attendance Course(s) for Teachers, Administrators, and Clerks.
