SUBJECT: HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES, 2022-2023

On Monday, January 22, 2024, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

According to the 2022-23 High School Graduation Rate FDOE press release "Florida's high school graduation rate increased by 0.7 percentage points over the last year, which continues to exceed the pre-pandemic rate. The graduation rate has increased significantly over the past nineteen years. The rate rose from 59.2 percent in 2003-2004 to 88.0 percent in 2022-2023, which is a 28.8 percentage-point increase."

Graduation rates in this memorandum will compare 2022-2023 to 2021-2022, highlights from this data include:

- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) Federal Graduation Rate is 88.7% which represents a 1.5 percentage points increase from the 2021-2022 (87.2%).
- The 2022-2023 graduation rate for Black students, Hispanic students, Asian students, American Indian or Alaska Native students, Two or More Races students, White students, Free and Reduced-Price Lunch (FRL) students, English Language Learners (ELL) students, At-Risk students and Students with Disabilities (SWD) in Broward exceeds the state.
- 34 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher and 22 of these schools reached a graduation rate at or above 95%.
- Six District high schools earned 100% graduation rates: Atlantic Technical High School, Broward Virtual Franchise, College Academy at Broward College, Lauderhill 6-12, Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy, and Pompano Beach High School. College Academy at Broward College achieved a graduation rate of 100% for the twelfth consecutive year.
- Four District high schools increased graduation rates by more than 5 percentage points in 2022-2023 compared to 2021-2022: Coconut Creek High School (10.8 percentage points), Blanche Ely High School (8.8 percentage points), Boyd Anderson High School (7 percentage points) and Northeast High School (6.4 percentage points).

- Florida's Federal graduation rate is 88.0% in 2022-23, which is an increase of 0.7 percentage points from 87.3% in 2021-22.

Subsequent pages provide further detail and analysis including a comparison of graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and graduation rates by school.

Table 1 displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State overall. In 2022-2023, Broward had a graduation rate of 88.7.



Table 1A shows the 2022-2023 graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State by subgroup. The 2022-2023 graduation rate for Black students, Hispanic students, White students, Free and FRL students, ELL students, and SWD in Broward exceeds the state.

Figure 1 illustrates the ten-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional District high schools, BCPS overall (including high schools, centers, and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional District high schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 95.5% in 2022-2023.

Table 2 shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rates increased for Black and Hispanic students. In 2022-2023, the gap between Black and White students decreased by 2.3 percentage points and the gap between Hispanic and White students decreased by 2.3 percentage points compared to 2021-22.

Table 3 shows the graduation rates by subgroups served in BCPS. ELL showed the largest increase in graduation rate up 4.9 percentage points from 2021-2022. SWD showed a 3.3 percentage points increase in graduation rate compared to 2021-2022. FRL students showed a 1.8 percentage points increase in graduation rate compared to 2021-2022. The graduation rate gaps for all subgroups decreased compared to 2021-2022. The gap for SWD and Non-SWD students decreased by 2.1 percentage points. The graduation rate gap between ELL and Non-ELL students increased by 3.1 percentage points to 16.7.

Appendix A shows the graduation rates for BCPS schools from 2018-2019 through 2022-2023. A review of the appendix shows that **34 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher**. Four District high schools increased graduation rates by more than 5 percentage points in 2022-2023 compared to 2021-2022: Coconut Creek High School (10.8 percentage points), Blanche Ely High School (8.8 percentage points), Boyd Anderson High School (7 percentage points) and Northeast High School (6.4 percentage points).

Appendix B shows the cohort size and graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS by school for the 2022-2023 graduation cohort.

Appendix C shows the historical graduation rates for 2012-2013 through 2022-2023 for BCPS by schools.
