To help you participate well in your class web conference follow these simple virtual meeting netiquette rules and tips:

- 1. Leave the keyboard alone
- 2. Dress appropriately
- 3. Be aware of your surroundings
- 4. Mute your microphone when you are not talking
- 5. Speak up, but do not shout
- 6. No food allowed
- 7. Stay seated and stay present
- 8. Find a quiet location with no or minimal background noise
- 9. Turn off all sounds on your phone
- 10. Parents should not interrupt meetings
